Republic Services supports Rebuilding Together of Greater Charlotte

CONCORD, NC (MAY 2, 2024) – Republic Services and Charlotte Motor Speedway Landfill are proud to be trusted members of the local community and our employees are committed to supporting organizations that work tirelessly to improve the areas where we live and work.

This year, **Rebuilding Together of Greater Charlotte** is one of 15 National Neighborhood Promise[®] grant recipients, each of whom received between \$100,000 and \$250,000.

In total, the organizations were awarded \$3 million to positively impact 2 million people and promote sustainable neighborhoods.

Rebuilding Together of Greater Charlotte is receiving \$150,000 to support renovations to the **Clearwater Arts Center**. Planned upgrades from this donation include additional garden seating, installation of a stage for concerts and events, creation of a large mural, planting trees and shrubs and covered seating at high-traffic bus stops.

"For nearly 40 years, we have enjoyed a stellar partnership with the City of Concord. We are beyond excited to expand upon this relationship and give back to our local community by revitalizing the Clearwater Arts Center," General Manager, Andrew Magee said.

Each 2024 National Neighborhood Promise grant is tailored to meet a specific community need, from facility repairs and improvements (including playground construction, computer labs and learning centers), to equipment purchases and neighborhood cleanup programs. The grants are issued through the Republic Services Charitable Foundation, which helps support Republic Services' 2030 Sustainability Goal to positively impact 45 million people.
